Have you been eligible for Free School Meals during your secondary schooling?

Are you the first generation of your family to attend university in the UK, having attended a school where 20% of its students are eligible for Free School Meals?

Did you get 5 A grades at GCSE or 5 A/B grades at National 5?

Did you get 4 A grades at GCSE or 4 A/B grades at National 5 but took these at a school with a 50% or lower GCSE pass rate (or Scottish equivalent)?

Are you predicted ABB at A Level or ABBB at Higher for the Aspiring Professionals Programme?
Or AAB/AABB for the J.P. Morgan Residential Programme?
